NEW FUNDED PROJECTS

The European Commission has officially notified the project consortia that got funded under the EURATOM2027 program. ENEN has got 100 PM over the following initiatives:

- ENEN2plus** - Mobilities for the whole nuclear community
- TANDEM** - Small Modular Reactors
- OFFERR** - Access to research infrastructures
- FREDMANS** - fuel recycle and advanced nuclear solutions
- GOVIKING** - vibrations impact in Nuclear installations
- SECURE** - supply chain of medical radionuclides

Dear ENEN Members, Colleagues and Friends, What a rich and eventful year has been!

Last summer and fall we worked hard to write the proposal of what would have become the new ENEN flagship project. A few weeks ago, we were officially notified that ENEN2plus will be a reality and will distribute about 2.5M€ in mobilities actions to preserve and further develop the expertise in the nuclear fields by higher education and training.

This was hopefully our last General Assembly online, life is getting more and more back to what it was before 2020 and hopefully our next General Assembly will finally be in person again.

My role within ENEN has changed. Indeed, my mandate as a President came to an end and I am gladly passing the *baton* to Associate Professor Csilla Pesznyák, while I will stay active in E&T and keep a seat in the ENEN Board of Directors as Past-President for one more year.

FOLLOW UP ON OUR INITIATIVES

All the mentioned projects have received funding from the European Commission.

TOURR: Towards optimized use of research reactors in Europe.

This project reached half of its life and data collection is proceeding smoothly. We are actively looking for contacts in realities connect to the RR word or medical radio-isotopes production.
