STEP 1: SELECTION OF COURSE(S) TO APPLY FOR

On the INSC T&T Project MC3.01/20 website <u>https://training.ek-cer.hu/</u> see the lists of Training Courses on the subpage <u>https://training.ek-cer.hu/training/</u> and Tutoring Courses on the subpage <u>https://training.ek-cer.hu/tutoring/</u>, and find the one(s) that interest(s) you.

Check your eligibility for participation.

STEP 2: APPLY FOR COURSE

- 5 curriculum vitae (CV) template.

You will receive a confirmation email if your application email has been received.
